- All words written in green are fully decodable. All words in red are tricky (non-decodable). They are referred to as green and red words.
- > The first 100 **HFWs** are all within the phases, with the decodable HFWs written in green and underlined.
- The decodable words from the 200 HFWs are within the phases and are identified in *green italics*.
- > Graphemes highlighted in yellow boxes are those that are included in the Letters and Sounds assessment are mostly the more common graphemes.
- > Letter and Sounds assessment to be used as often as needed, to ensure pupils are on track with planning.
- > 105 days to complete Phase 5 = 22 weeks = roughly 4 half terms.
