The BIGGEST influencer in realtion to reading ability is READING FOR PLEASURE <sup>(C)</sup> We need children who love books and reading, who are excited to choose a book, to listen to it being read, or to read it to themselves. A bedtime story is the perfect anchor for this, no matter the age of the child or stage of development. <u>In this way,</u> <u>being read TO, is MORE important than learning to</u> read!!

A bedtime story has the potential to have a lasting effect on lives. It is never too late to start this, or too late to stop. If listening to a reader is fun, special, and consistentthe research shows it increases academic ability and <u>overall lifetime happiness!</u>
